



"... Undoubtedly, one of the most dramatic developments in the history of RTS was the establishment of a campus in Orlando, spurred by the offer of \$20 million from two donors in response to the vision of becoming an institution of national prominence and influence. In 1989, two years after their offer and the eventual withdrawal of it, RTS opened a small campus in the Maitland Center Commons in 1989, becoming the first accredited Protestant seminary in Florida.. A stellar faculty included RC Sproul, Richard Pratt, and Roger Nicole. They were soon joined by Elmer Smick, Charles MacKenzie, Ron Nash and others. John Muether is the only remaining member of that original faculty. Life was never the same again..."

A respected leader in the evangelical community, he serves on the board of the World Evangelical Alliance (420 million constituents) and the National Association of Evangelicals (30 million members). Dr. Hunter recently declined an offer to become the president of the Christian Coalition when the group could not embrace his vision to expand their political agenda to include compassion issues.

Dr. Hunter is also partnering with other groups to accomplish common goals. He is working with respected members of the scientific community to call attention to human-caused threats to the environment. Additionally, as a delegate to the US-Islamic World Forum held in Doha, he is seeking to build a dialog between Muslim and Christian communities. Grist magazine named him among the top 15 religious environmental leaders in the world, along with the Pope and the Dali Lama..."

New Yorker bio for Joel Hunter:

"...Dr. Joel C. Hunter, the senior pastor of Northland church in Orlando, Florida, who every week preaches to ten thousand people in his church and through the Internet, is one of the new leaders. Long active in community affairs, he has become an activist on the national level. He has lobbied Congress for legislation to curb global warming, pressed for comprehensive immigration reform, and denounced the virulent anti-immigrant rhetoric of the Republican primaries. He has worked with a group of evangelicals and secular progressives to try to establish common ground on such polarizing issues as abortion and the role of religion in public life. "I think the way we have been dealing with differences in this country simply doesn't work," Hunter told me recently. He is on the board of the National Association of Evangelicals, and with his fellow-members he has condemned Bush Administration policies permitting torture and the inhumane treatment of detainees. He has also twice attended the U.S.-Islamic World Forum, an annual gathering of American and Muslim leaders in Qatar, sponsored by the Brookings Institution. After the first meeting, where Hunter discovered that even the American diplomats assumed that all evangelicals believed that Israel had a Biblical right to the Palestinian territories, he and eighty-

three colleagues sent an open letter to President Bush, calling for a two-state solution and justice for both the Israelis and the Palestinians. The statement was "hardly revolutionary," Hunter said, with a grin, "but it was subversive," meaning subversive of the religious right..."

Some of Joel's latest projects

"... In 2007, Hunter was among more than two dozen scientific and evangelical leaders who met secretly at a retreat in Thomasville, Ga., to draft a joint statement calling for immediate action on so-called climate change.

After that meeting, Hunter worked with a group, Conservation International, to draft a tool kit titled "Creation Care: An Introduction for Busy Pastors" to send to evangelical leaders.

They produced a package of Bible passages and information on scientific findings to promote action on "climate change."

He is part of a group of evangelicals and progressives who organize under the auspices of the left-leaning "Third Way" organization. There, he helped draft a new position paper, "Come Let Us Reason Together: A Fresh Look at Shared Cultural Values Between Progressives and Evangelicals," that calls for common ground on abortion, same sex marriage, and stem cell research, among other social issues. "Third Way" is an ideology first promoted as an alternative to free markets by Mikhail Gorbachev after the collapse of the Soviet Empire. The "Third Way" of governing would be neither capitalist nor communist, but something in between.

George Soros has been a major proponent of "Third Way" economic policy.

Besides reaching out to progressives, Hunter has led multiple initiatives on U.S.-Islamic outreach. He was a delegate to the recent U.S.-Islamic World Forum held in Doha, Qatar, seeking to build a dialogue between Muslim and Christian communities.

He has spoken at numerous interfaith forums, including a 2009 Georgetown University panel, "A Common Word: Religious Pluralism in the 21st Century..."

And Joel Hunter and RC Sproul also know each other through Rockefeller's Gordon College and Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary connections. RC Sproul doesn't explain what he was teaching at Gordon College or Conwell School of Theology (before it was Gordon-Conwell, separate from Gordon College). RC Sproul did teach for two years at Gordon College, and then 3+ years at Conwell School of Theology (before it was Gordon-Conwell, yet separate from Gordon College). Then RC Sproul was a "visiting professor" of Apologetics at Gordon-Conwell (after the name change) from 1971 to 1981 = 10 years. Joel Hunter has some sort of direct friendship with Gordon-Conwell's president, who has signed 2 of his "open-letters" to the government on various subjects.
